## His Wounds

In John 20:24-29, we see Thomas continues to doubt the resurrection until he sees and touches the wounds in Jesus' hands and side. Jesus tells him that he believes because he has seen Him, but blessed all those who believe in Him yet have not seen. But, why did God not heal Jesus? Surely, His mere presence and later ascension would be proof enough for even doubting Thomas. The standard answer is to let the Apostles know it is "the" one and only Jesus. However, let me postulate another reason.

The wounds prove Jesus was one of us. As John states in John 1:14 (NIV), "the Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us." Jesus was wounded and broken, suffering on behalf of us all. His wounds are our wounds. His broken body is our brokenness. Through His blood we are forgiven. His crucifixion and resurrection completes the bridge to God through our recognition that He is "the way, the truth and the life." John 14:5 (NIV)

Those nails driven into Him fasten the planks of that bridge which is between our mortal lives and the Kingdom of God. As we learn in the Talk, The Priesthood of All Believers, we are to stand in the gap with Him. We stand in that gap with our own wounds until we take Jesus' hand and cross that bridge to final victory

## The Ten Lepers

*Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!" When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed. One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan. Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well." Luke 17:11-19*

Ever since my Emmaus Walk last September 2014, this story from the Gospels has been coming to my mind. Only recently did I pay attention to the repeated "nudges" from God and sit down to read the passage. While I do not know what God wants to say to you through it, I want to share it with you in faith that He *is* speaking. Are you listening?

I also want to encourage you: don't make my mistake and wait 6 months or 6 weeks or 6 hours to do something that God is prompting you to do. I am speaking of things that are obviously good that there's no way the devil would want you to do. Even if you don't understand why God wants you to do something, DO IT ANYWAY!! Once you obey him, God will show you more of his purposes. (Notice that the lepers were only cleansed *as they went and did what they would have done if they were cleansed*— that is, to show themselves to the priest, be pronounced ceremonially clean and restored to the community.)

As for me, I want to be like the leper who was cleansed who came back to Jesus, praising God. God did AMAZING, healing work during the Emmaus Walk I was privileged to experience. A matter that has caused me pain and hindered my relationships with God and others for nearly my whole life was unraveled and restored. PRAISE GOD— WITH A LOUD VOICE!!

I also want to thank each of you, including MANY people I have never met, for being the body of Christ to me in that time. Thank you for being faithful to God and for serving me, each of you in your own way. *I am humbled and grateful.* I received so many unique gifts— spiritual "treasures"— from God during the Walk, that I do not know how to begin talking about them, or thanking you. These experiences have encouraged me daily since that time. I want to reaffirm right now that I am counting on Christ.
