When the Lord Comes

How often do you think about the return of Jesus? We are told that it will happen without warning. Jesus said, "*So be on your guard! You don't know when your Lord will come*" Matthew 24:42. When I think about it, I often wonder what the judgment will be like. Many people think that judgment will be for things we did wrong, the sins we have committed, but the Bible tells us that God does not remember our sins. When we accept Jesus as Lord of our life and repent of our sins, God forgets all our sins. As Isaiah told us long ago, God says "*But I wipe away your sins because of who I am. And so, I will forget the wrongs you have done.*" Isaiah 43:25.

So if God says he does not remember our sins, what criteria do you think he might use to judge us when he returns? In the parable of the three servants, Jesus tells how he will reward the servants who used wisely what he had given them. (Matthew 25:14-30) Some translations of this parable use words describing money and other translations use the word "Talents", in either case, I think Jesus wants us to use our resources (money and talents) wisely for Him and His work in the kingdom. Jesus also tells us the criteria for judgment in Matthew 25:31-46. He says we will be judged by what we did or didn't do for Him, not by the sins we committed against God.

It's easy to become too busy and let our service to God suffer because of our busyness. God calls us to serve Him. I have heard people use the excuse that they are not qualified, I am sure I have even used that excuse myself, but when we serve with the right motives, God will equip us to succeed. How will you serve God? How are you serving in your Church, your local community, your Emmaus community?
